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# **B.** Purpose

Indiana University (IU) is requesting proposals from firms interested in providing [dental laboratory services to the IU School of Dentistry (IUSD), located on the Indiana University Indianapolis campus], as specified herein. The intent of this Request for Proposal (RFP) and the ensuing process is to provide companies with the information, requirements, and specifications necessary for the preparation of a professional and comprehensive proposal. Specific terms and conditions are outlined.

Selection of the successful company (Suppliers) will be based upon a variety of factors such as:

- Turn-around time, acceptance of order to delivery of product
- Ability to Meet Technical Specifications for both complex and standard orders, and quality of finished product
- Price
- Low redo/remake rates
- Cost of redo/remakes, prefer no-cost
- Ability to accept high-volume orders, as well as custom orders
- Ability to accept both digital/electronic images and physical impressions/models/casts
- Provide feedback to faculty and students as needed

These criteria are listed in order of importance.

As used within this RFP, "Participant" shall refer to those companies receiving and responding to this RFP. "Supplier" shall refer to the successful Participant of the process. "University" shall refer to Indiana University.

#### C. Background

The Indiana University School of Dentistry (IUSD) is one of the oldest dental schools in the nation. For 140 years, we've made a difference in the lives of the people of Indiana, the U.S., and the world, and we're continuing to advance oral health by preparing the next generation of oral health professionals, conducting innovative research that's shaping the profession, and providing oral health care to

thousands of people each year. Each year more than 19,000 patients receive care from students training to become dentists, hygienists, and other oral health professionals at the School of Dentistry. We offer a full range of oral health care services, including general dentistry, advanced care, and emergency care. In FY 2022-23 completed more than 80,000 patient appointments and placed approximately 4,000 orders through a variety of dental laboratories.

#### F. Statement of Needs

# **Objectives:**

Indiana University School of Dentistry (IUSD) seeks to contract with one or more dental laboratories for the procurement of a wide variety of services and fabricated dental products, including, but not limited to, full and partial dentures, both fixed and removable, fixed restorations, crowns, implants, digital CAD-CAM transmission capability and much more.

IUSD's objective is to contract with the fewest number of dental laboratories as will be optimal to ensure that IUSD can meet the needs of its patients and students, for both standard general dentistry needs and for complex advanced dentistry needs in the areas of prosthodontics care, such as implants. Successful laboratories will need to be highly price competitive, but also be able to ensure timeliness of delivery of completed materials, highest quality, lowest rate of remakes, and be able to provide feedback to faculty and students.

# Scope of Work:

A spreadsheet with the listing of dental laboratory services by dental procedure code and code descriptor that IUSD ordered from external laboratories in FY 2022-23, along with the cumulative count of each procedure ordered during that fiscal year is attached to the Buyer Attachments in the Sourcing Event. These are the explicit services IUSD seeks to procure from the successful laboratories through this RFP contract. This is not intended to be an exhaustive list, and additional services may be added. Participants can submit a bid on all services or on a subset of services.

We are seeking to establish a three (3) year term with the option to renew for up to two (2) additional one (1) year terms.

Indiana University reserves the right to approve or reject any subcontracting agent or to reject proposals based on the use of subcontracted work.
- H1.4 Completed Non-Collusive Certificate (Prerequisites section of BUY.IU/Jaggaer RFP).
- H1.5 Completed Supplier Diversity form (Prerequisites section of BUY.IU/Jaggaer RFP).
- H1.6 Completed Federal Debarment Certification form (Prerequisites section of BUY.IU/Jaggaer RFP).
